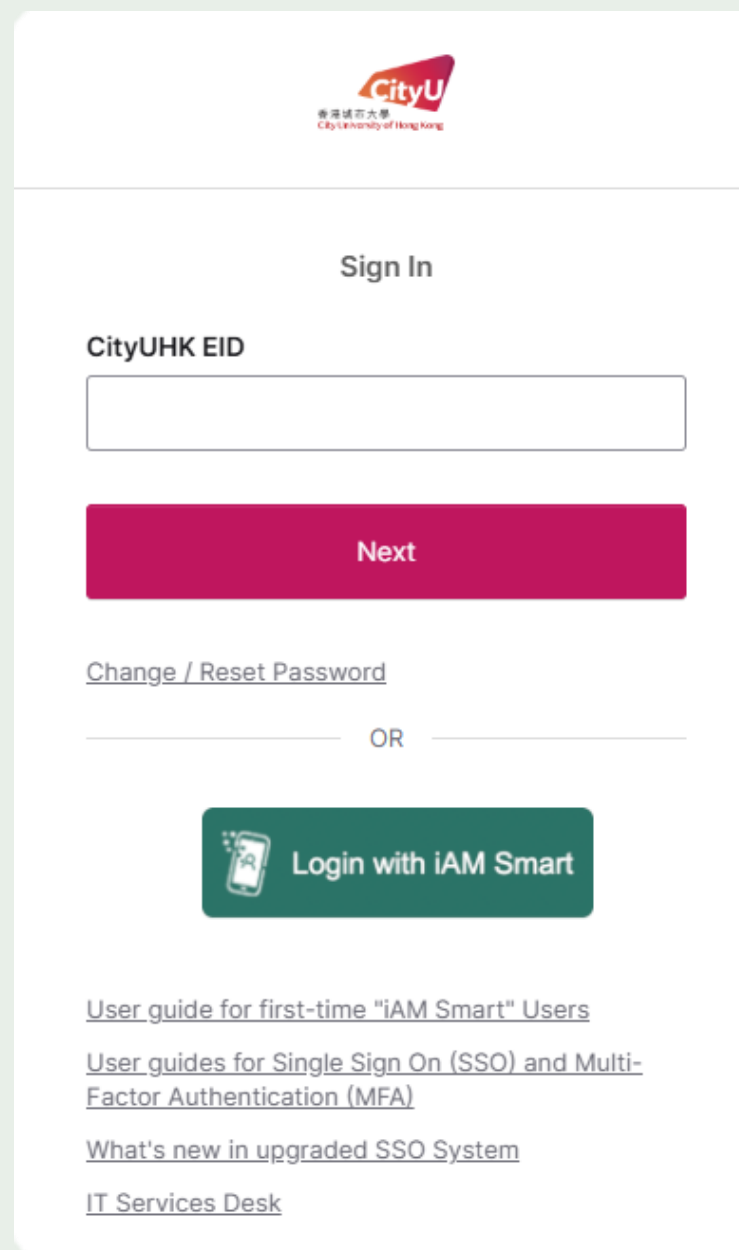

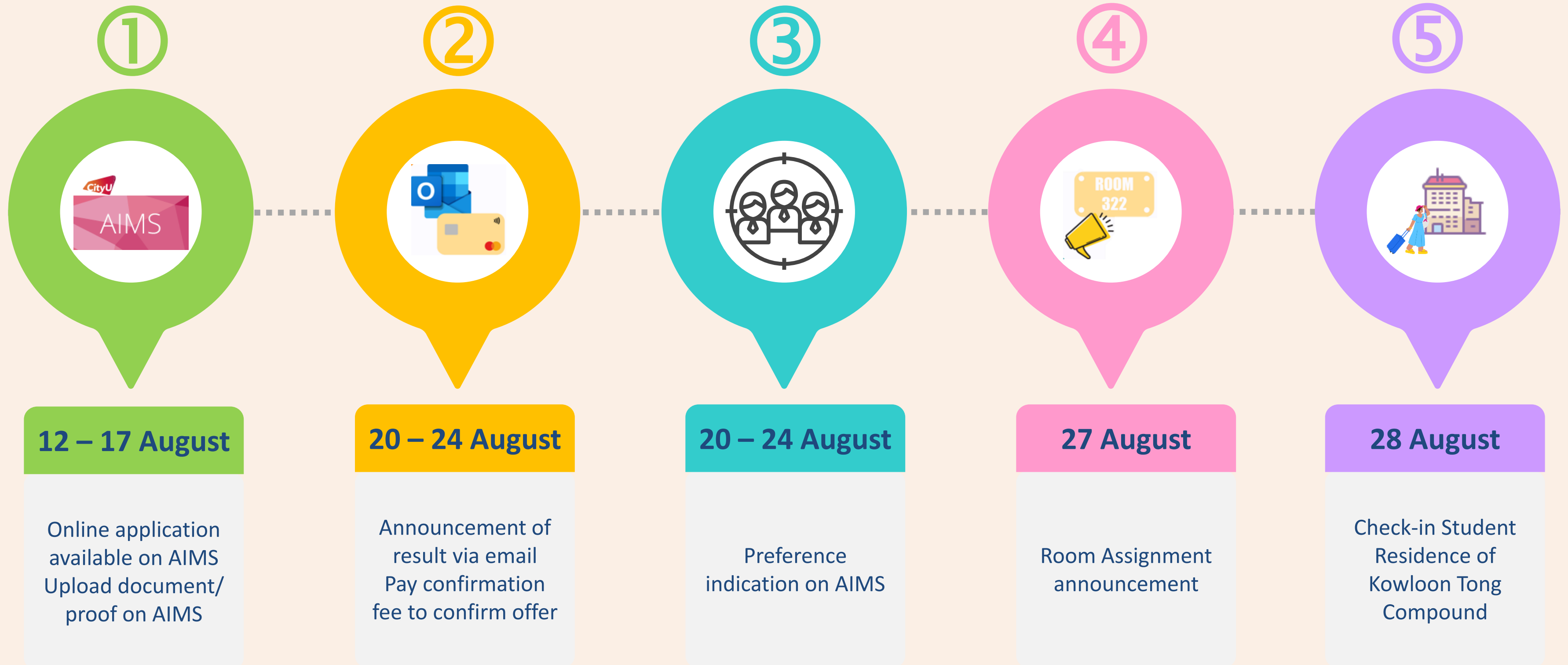

1. General Application Information

UG Hall Lodging Fee 2026/27

Rate for Double Room (per person)
\$17,300 / year



Rate for Single Room (per person)
\$34,600 / year



Residential period: 28 August 2026, 9am – 24 May 2027, 12noon

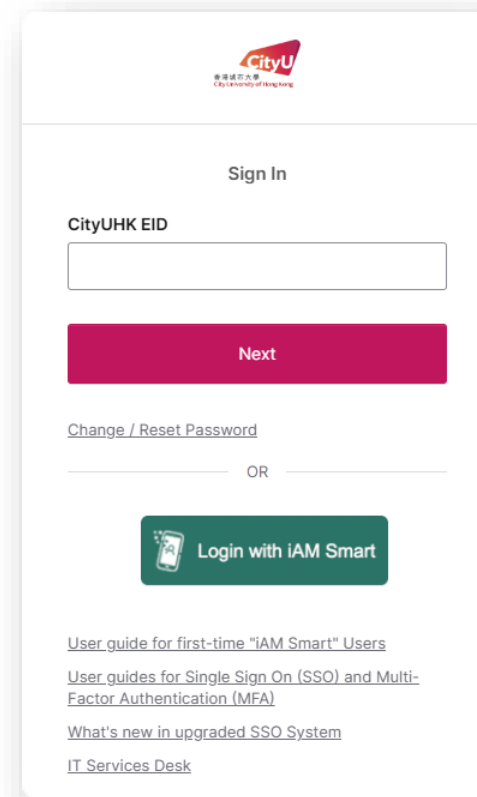
Important Note

1. Hall lodging fee of residential year 2026/27 is payable in two instalments to cover the whole residential period. **1st instalment** and **2nd instalment** will be charged in student account (tentative) in **September** and **December** respectively. The due date of 1st instalment is (tentative) in September and 2nd instalment is in January.
2. Full residential year hall place is offered to residents. No withdrawal from the Student Residence is expected. Once you accept the hall offer, you are liable to settle the remaining hall lodging fee, which will be charged into your student account in residential year 2026/27 even you move out earlier or do not complete the check-in procedure for any reason.
3. The hall lodging fee payment is non-deferrable on all conditions, hence successful applicants are expected to have sufficient fund for a timely payment before accepting the hall offer.

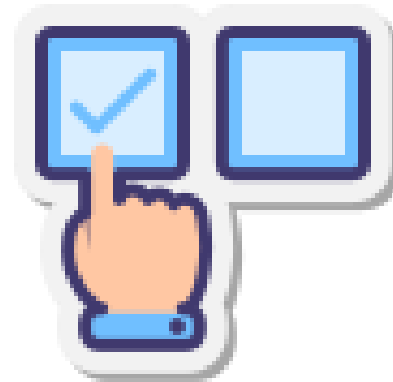

2. Application Procedure

Score A

Based on the ranking of one's **combined score** of “Home Environment and Commuting Time”



Home Environment

- State the home size including kitchen and bathroom (in **sq.ft**)
Public Rental Flats or Private Flats
- State the household members' name and relationship with the applicant (e.g. Chan Siu Ming (myself), Chan Tai Man (father))

Note:  **Pets are NOT counted as household members**



Commuting Time

- Choose district of home address (Students shall keep proof of their home address within the latest 3 months when/if necessary [i.e. 17 May 2026 to 17 August 2026])
- Information submitted should reflect your current situation during the application period

Tips to applicants

***The system will show your information by default.**

***Add Household member (if any)**

Tips 1: Make sure the name is correct

For example : Wrong spelling → “Ch**a**ng” instead of “Ch**e**ng”

Tips 2: Make sure all the information is **TRUE and **ACCURATE**,**
serious misleading cases will be subject to further disciplinary actions.

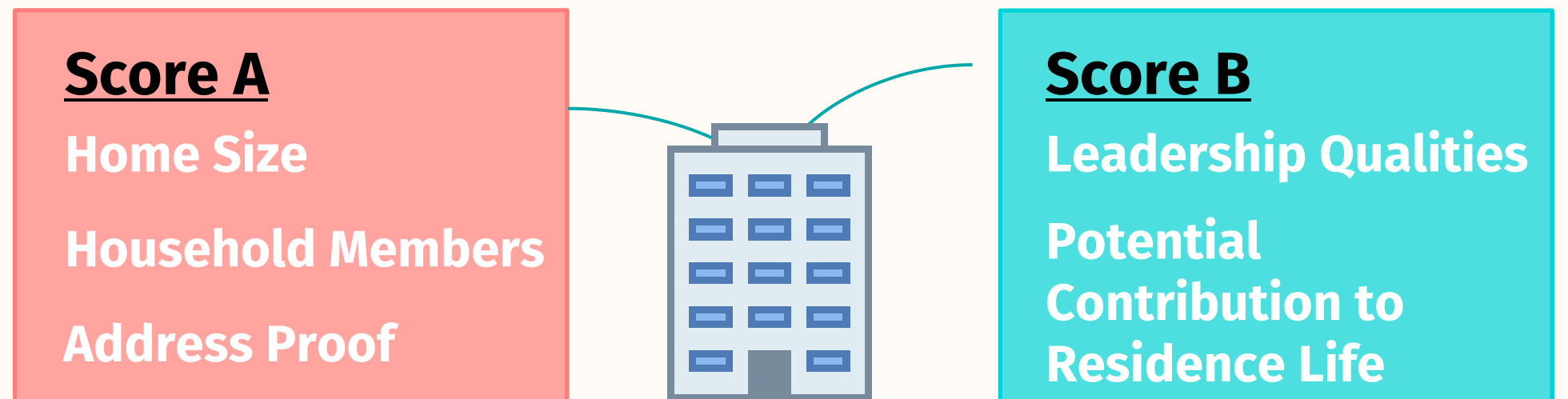

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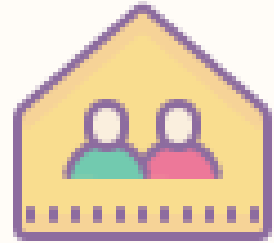
Vetting

Note: **DO** keep all document proofs relating to your hall application.

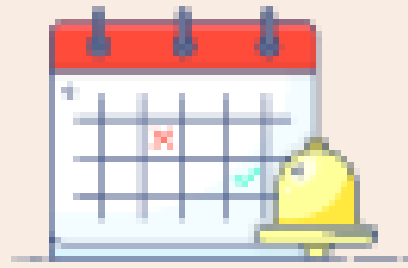

3. Vetting, Room Assignment



Room Assignment

- Rule of thumb: All applicants will be assigned to double-room double-occupancy if no preference is indicated.
- Applicants' preferences will be considered **as far as possible**.
- There is **no guarantee** that one will be assigned to a particular hall, unit, room type, or with a specific roommate. Final room assignment is subject to room availability and hall admission policies.
- SRO and the Residence Masters reserve the right to make alternative assignment decisions or re-assign students when necessary.
- **No room assignment will be made if applicants fail to confirm their hall offer.**
