

FAQ (Kowloon Tong Compound)

For Local students without hall experience or staying in the hall less than 120 days

Question 1 Can I choose both Kowloon Tong (KLNT) Compound and Ma On Shan (MOS) Compound or can I choose KLNT Compound as 1st priority compound, MOS Compound as 2nd priority.

Answer: NO. You can only indicate KLNT Compound or MOS Compound in the application.

Question 2 I live in Ma On Shan/ Kowloon Tong or near either one Student Residence, does it mean that I have no chance to live in the student residence?

Answer: For those students who are failing to get the hall offer via Score A & B, you still have a chance to get a bedplace via lottery.

Hence, students are strongly advised to submit the hall application first by 30 March 2026.

Question 3 Can I change the selected compound?

Answer: YES. Before the application deadline (30 March 2026), you can login AIMS again to amend. However, no amendment is allowed after the application deadline.

Question 4 For Score B, I cannot provide any document proof or certification, is it compulsory to fill Score B?

Answer: NO, it is NOT compulsory to fill Score B. You can simply leave it blank.

Question 5 What should I do if I don't know my home size in square feet?

Question 6 Can I amend the information on the application after submission?

Answer: YES. You can amend your application before the application deadline (30 March 2026).

Question 7 When should I submit my supporting documents for hall application?

Answer: You may upload documents while submitting your application or submit upon request.

Question 8 When will the application result be announced?

The application result will be released on 30 April 2026.

Question 9 How can I accept the hall offer?

Answer: Upon the application result announcement, students have to pay a Confirmation Fee to indicate the acceptance of the offer by a specified deadline. The Confirmation Fee is non-refundable and non-transferable. NO bed place will be reserved if you miss the payment deadline.

Question 10 Can I change the compound or withdrawal after I confirm the hall offer?

Answer: NO. Hence, you are advised to consider carefully before accepting the offer.
